Dete ubijeno hicem iz vatrenog oružja

Sedmogodišnji Nermin Divović leži na ulici u zloglasnoj sarajevskoj "Aleji snajpera", juče, ubijen metkom u glavu. Vatrogasci Ujedinjenih nacija su gotovo odmah došli na lice mjesta, ali dječak je već bio mrtav. Njegova majka, Dženana Sokolović, pogođena je u stomak tokom snajperskog napada, a još dvoje ljudi je, ranije tog dana, ranjeno na području snajperskog napada. Po vladinim procjenama, 17.000 djece – Srba, Hrvata i Muslimana – ubijeno je tokom dvoipogodišnjeg rata u Bosni i Hercegovini.

Child gunned down

Nermin Divovic, 7, lies in the street in Sarajevo's notorious "Sniper Alley" yesterday, dead of a bullet wound to the head. U.N. firefighters were on the scene almost immediately, but the boy was already dead. His mother, Dzenana Sokolovic, was shot in the stomach during the sniper attack and two other people were wounded in area sniper attacks earlier in the day. The government estimates nearly 17,000 children — Serbs, Croats and Muslims — have been killed in the 2 1/2-year-old war in Bosnia-Herzegovina:
