

1. **GENERAL ASSESSMENT.** THE AOR IN GENERAL WAS QUIET. SECTOR SARAJEVO WAS AGAIN REASONABLY ACTIVE ALTHOUGH

SIGNIFICANTLY LESS THAN YESTERDAY. A UN AIRCRAFT AND A TRAM WERE ENGAGED BY SA FIRE. THE BLOCKADE OF GORNJI VAKUF CONTINUES ALTHOUGH THE SITUATION DID IMPROVE TODAY. BIHAC REMAINED QUIET AND ANOTHER UNHCR CONVOY REACHED THE POCKET. GORAZDE SAW AN INCREASE IN ACTIVITY BUT THE FIRING INCIDENT LEVELS REMAINED LOW. THE MED/SOCIAL EVACUATION HAS BEEN APPROVED TO TAKE PLACE ON 1 MAR 95.

2. HEAVY WEAPONS EXCLUSION ZONE VIOLATIONS. NTR.

3. FACTION ACTIVITY.

A. SECTOR SARAJEVO. ANOTHER TENSE DAY WAS EXPERIENCED BY SARAJEVO. THE NUMBER OF FIRING INCIDENTS DECREASED SIGNIFICANTLY COMPARED TO YESTERDAY BUT THE TOTAL IS STILL HIGH. SOME FIRING INCIDENTS AGAINST AIRCRAFT WERE REPORTED FROM THE AIRPORT TODAY (SEE PARA 8B). A CIVILIAN WOMAN WAS KILLED BY A 120mm MORTAR ROUND IN HRASNICA (BP846523). ONE 40mm RIFLE GRENADE, POSSIBLY BiH, EXPLODED IN DOBRINJA EAST (BP873558). NO CASUALTIES. 8 X SA ROUNDS WERE FIRED AT A TRAM NEAR THE HOLIDAY INN (BP910593) INJURING 4 (NOT CONFIRMED) PEOPLE. THE ORIGIN IS ASSESSED AS BEING IN THE VRBANJA BRIDGE/RED BUILDING AREA (BP912589) WHERE A FIREFIGHT BETWEEN BOTH FACTIONS OCCURRED AT THE SAME TIME. THE TRAM SERVICE WAS HALTED. A PROPOSED RECCE OF THE KRUPAC AREA WAS CANCELLED DUE TO NON-COOPERATION BY THE BiH. A LETTER OF PROTEST HAS BEEN SENT TO THE BiH IN ORDER TO RESOLVE THIS SITUATION. THE SECTOR CONTINUES TO PROVIDE VEHICLES AND DRIVERS TO UNHCR. THE BLUE ROUTES REMAINED OPEN TODAY WITH 565 VEHICLES AND 3882 PEOPLE CROSSING THE AIRPORT. THE VISIT OF THE TURKISH PRESIDENT TO SARAJEVO WAS CANCELLED TODAY. THE COMD'S INTENTION IS TO RESTORE NORMAL LEVELS OF CIVIL ACTIVITY AFTER THE RECENT DISRUPTIONS DUE TO ISOLATED FIRING INCIDENTS.

B. SECTOR SOUTH WEST. A GENERALLY QUIET DAY WITH AN IMPROVEMENT IN THE BLOCKADE SITUATION. THE BLOCKADE WAS PARTIALLY LIFTED AT THE NORTHERN LOCATION BY CP B13 (049693). WHETHER THIS WAS INTENTIONAL IS UNCLEAR. THERE ARE INDICATIONS THAT THEY ARE INTENDING TO TRY A DIFFERENT APPROACH AND POSSIBLY ESCALATE THE SITUATION. THE SITUATION AT CP M CONTINUES. IT WAS VISITED TODAY BY THE JCMEC (JOINT COMMISSION OF THE MILITARY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE). IT WOULD APPEAR THE COS OF THE BIH SECURITY POLICE AND COMD 16 DIV ARE ACTING INDEPENDENTLY WITH LITTLE DIRECTION. THIS COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED. THE BLUE ROUTE BETWEEN VISOKO AND SARAJEVO REMAINED CLOSED TODAY DUE TO THE SITUATION AT CP M.

C. SECTOR NORTH EAST. SECTOR NE WAS RELATIVELY STABLE. THE ONLY UPSET WAS A REPORTED INCREASE IN ACTIVITY IN THE MAJEVICA HILLS. ON INVESTIGATION, A MAJOR THUNDERSTORM OCCURRED IN THE AREA WHICH MAY HAVE RESULTED IN MISREPORTING. INVESTIGATIONS ARE CONTINUING. AN ATTACK ON A UN CONVOY WAS TARGETED IN THE RIBNICA AREA (SEE PARA 8A). COMD'S INTENTIONS ARE THE RESUPPLY OF MED STORES FOR DUTCHBAT (SEE PARA 15B(2)(E)), IMPROVEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS ON MOVEMENT.

D. BIHAC AREA. ANOTHER QUIET DAY IN THE BIHAC POCKET ALTHOUGH SEVERAL FIRING INCIDENTS WERE RECORDED AROUND THE CL. BIHAC TOWN WAS NOT SHELLED BUT A FEW EXPLOSIONS AND SPORADIC FIRING INCIDENTS WERE REGISTERED IN THE SAFE AREA. VELIKA Kladusa WAS EXTREMELY QUIET WITH FEW REPORTED FIRING INCIDENTS. A SMALL NUMBER OF SHELLS LANDED IN THE AREA OF CAZIN. CORALICI REMAINED QUIET. THERE WAS NO SHIFT IN THE CL TODAY. A UNHCR CONVOY REACHED CAZIN IN THE LATE AFTERNOON. BANBAT DISTRIBUTED 29 TONNES OF RELIEF MATERIALS TO VELIKA Kladusa.

E. GORAZDE. THERE HAS BEEN A SLIGHT INCREASE IN ACTIVITY IN THE EAST BANK AREA AND AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF BSA PATROLS AROUND THE 3 km TEZ. HOWEVER, THERE WAS ONLY ONE CEASEFIRE VIOLATION REPORTED. THE UNPROFOR INTERPRETER, GORAN POSVANDZIC, SPENT HIS 9TH NIGHT IN PRISON. THE BIH AUTHORITIES ARE ADAMANT HE WILL NOT BE RELEASED UNTIL THE DECISION IS MADE IN SARAJEVO. A FURTHER CONVOY OF TROOPS FROM 1 RWF ARRIVED TODAY. THE CONVOY WAS SEARCHED THOROUGHLY BUT NO EQUIPMENT WAS CONFISCATED. THE MEDICAL AND SOCIAL EVACUATION SET FOR THE 1 MAR 95 HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE BSA. THE COMD'S FUTURE INTENTIONS ARE TO TRY AND ESTABLISH A VISITATION PROGRAMME BETWEEN RELATIONS/FORMER FRIENDS, TO NEGOTIATE MORE MED/SOCIAL EVACS, TO ENCOURAGE FURTHER COMMERCIAL CONVOYS AND TO CONTINUE THE INCREASE IN CONFIDENCE ON BOTH SIDES IN THE COHA.

5. REPORTS ON MEETINGS WITH THE FACTIONS.

A. BIHAC. CO BANBAT MET WITH MR ABDIC IN VELIKA Kladusa AT 1100A TODAY. THEY DISCUSSED UNPROFOR'S FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT IN THE AREA AND OTHER PENDING ISSUES. UNPROFOR CONVOYS SHOULD GET AN IMPROVEMENT IN FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT UNTIL MID-MARCH, THE SITUATION WILL THEN BE RE-ASSESSED. MR ABDIC REFERRED TO HIS MEETING WITH MR MOUSALI, HEAD OF CIVIL AFFAIRS. ON 12 DEC 94. HE IS STILL AWAITING UNPROFOR'S RESPONSE. THE ICRC MEETING SCHEDULED TODAY FOR "JAPANESE JUNCTION" (WK593697) WAS POSTPONED TODAY DUE TO BAD WEATHER (HELICOPTERS UNABLE TO FLY DELEGATES TO VENUE). IT HAS BEEN RE-SCHEDULED FOR TOMORROW AT 281030A. THE BSA HAVE SAID THEY WILL NOT ATTEND AS "ISSUES REGARDING POW EXCHANGE CAN BE RESOLVED AT THE MEETINGS IN SARAJEVO AIRPORT".

MILITARY INFORMATION SUMMARY

1. BHC OVERALL ASSESSMENT. THE AOR, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE BIHAC POCKET AND SARAJEVO, IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN RELATIVELY QUIET FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THERE REMAINS CONCERN ABOUT CONTACTS BETWEEN WARRING FACTIONS REOCCUPYING FORWARD POSITIONS AS SPRING WEATHER APPROACHES. THERE WERE 4 X CFV'S REPORTED.

2. SECTOR SARAJEVO. THE LEVEL OF FIRING INCIDENTS DECREASED, BUT CONTINUED TO BE ABOVE NORMAL FOR THE SECTOR. AREAS IN THE VICINITY OF THE AIRPORT AND THE HOLIDAY INN WERE THE MOST ACTIVE. 3 X CFV'S WERE RECORDED.

A 120MM MORTAR ROUND FIRED INTO HRASNICA (BP 846523) FROM AN UNDETERMINED ORIGIN KILLED ONE BOSNIAN CIVILIAN. THIS WAS RECORDED AS A FIRING INCIDENT.

A PROBABLE BIH 40MM RIFLE GRENADE ALLEGEDLY FIRED FROM BIH TERRITORY (BP 870559) EXPLODED IN DOBRINJA EAST (BP 873558); NO CASUALTIES WERE SUSTAINED. THIS WAS RECORDED AS A SA CFV ATTRIBUTED TO THE BIH.

A TRAM TRAVELLING BETWEEN BP 910593 AND BP 907592 WAS FIRED AT, REPORTEDLY RESULTING IN 1 CONFIRMED CIVILIAN CASUALTY AND POSSIBLY 3 OTHER CASUALTIES. THE CONFIRMED CASUALTY SUFFERED A LEG INJURY. THE ESTIMATED ORIGIN OF FIRE WAS BP 907589. TRAMWAY SERVICE CEASED FOLLOWING THE INCIDENT. DURING THE SAME TIME PERIOD, BOTH SIDES WERE INVOLVED IN A FIREFIGHT 300 METRES AWAY IN THE AREA OF THE VRBANJA BRIDGE (BP 912589). A MG CFV HAS BEEN ATTRIBUTED TO BOTH THE BIH AND BSA FOR THE EVENT OVERALL.

AT 0950A, A FEW SA BURSTS WERE FIRED AT AN AIRCRAFT WHILE AT LOW ALTITUDE AND CLOSE TO THE AIRPORT. THE FIRING POINT WAS REPORTED TO BE IN STUP (BP 853564). THIS HAS BEEN RECORDED AS A SA CFV ATTRIBUTED TO THE BSA. OTHER SA BURSTS WERE HEARD AS AIRCRAFT WERE LANDING AND TAKING OFF DURING THE PERIOD 1208A UNTIL 1318A.

IN THE MOUNT IGMAN DMZ, SA FIRING INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED IN THE NORTHWESTERN PART OF THE AREA. THE RECCE SCHEDULED FOR THE KRUPAC AREA (BP 8650) WAS CANCELLED GIVEN THE UNWILLINGNESS OF THE 4 (BIH) BDE COMMANDER TO PARTICIPATE.

THE ZEPA ENCLAVE (CP 5372) WAS CALMER THAN ON 26 FEB. THE ONLY REPORTED EXPLOSION OCCURRED AT 0845A, 200M FROM UNPROFOR CP#2 (CP 482668).

ASSESSMENT. ALTHOUGH THE NUMBER OF FIRING INCIDENTS DECREASED, TENSION IS LIKELY TO REMAIN AT AN ELEVATED LEVEL FOLLOWING THE SHOOTING INCIDENTS BY UNCONTROLLED ELEMENTS AT THE AIRPORT AND AGAINST THE TRAM. IF TRAM OPERATIONS CAN BE RESTORED WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT, THE LEVEL OF TENSION IN THE AREA IS EXPECTED TO DIMINISH SOMEWHAT. CONTINUED SHOOTING AT CIVILIANS AND DIGGING ACTIVITIES BY BOTH WARRING FACTIONS, HOWEVER, WILL EVENTUALLY LEAD TO HEIGHTENED FEARS OF A COLLAPSE OF THE CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES AGREEMENT IN THE CITY.

THE M-36 PREVIOUSLY REPORTED IN THE STRAISTA (BP 858462) AREA WAS CONFIRMED TO BELONG TO THE BSA.

3. SECTOR SOUTHWEST. THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM WITH ONLY SPORADIC SA FIRE AND EXPLOSIONS NOTED. NO CFV'S WERE REPORTED.

THE UN CAMP IN GORNJI VAKUF (YJ 0768) WAS HIT BY SA FIRE DURING THE NIGHT 26/27 FEB; NO CASUALTIES OCCURRED AND LITTLE DAMAGE WAS SUSTAINED. COMMENT: THIS IS BELIEVED TO BE ASSOCIATED WITH THE PRESENCE OF THE BSA LO IN HQ SSW.

THE MAGLAJ FINGER WAS SLIGHTLY MORE ACTIVE, WITH THE BIH APPEARING TO PROVOKE A RESPONSE FROM BSA ELEMENTS IN THE AREA. THE UN BASE IN MAGLAJ (BQ 6937) WAS ALSO HIT BY PROBABLE BIH HARASSING SA FIRE.

THE BLOCKADE AT CP M IN THE VISOKO AREA (BP 7575) CONTINUED.

**ASSESSMENT.** FIRING INCIDENTS IN THE AREA ARE LIKELY TO BECOME MORE FREQUENT AS TROOPS FROM BOTH WARRING FACTIONS MOVE BACK INTO THEIR POSITIONS AFTER THE WINTER.

THERE IS A STRONG POSSIBILITY THAT THE BIH WILL CARRY OUT THEIR LATEST THREAT TO TAKE FURTHER ACTION AGAINST THE BSA LO PRESENCE AT HQ SSW. DIRECT BIH ACTIONS AGAINST THE BSA LO'S IS CONSIDERED UNLIKELY GIVEN UNPROFOR SECURITY PRECAUTIONS, AND BLOCKADES AGAINST THE HQ CAMP ARE ASSESSED AS UNLIKELY GIVEN THE HQ'S LOCATION IN CROAT TERRITORY.

AT 270400A, 500 X BIH TROOPS PASSED A CHECKPOINT AT BP 678710 IN 10 BUSES. THEY WERE TRAVELLING NE FROM KISELJAK (BP 6569) TOWARD VISOKO (BP 7575).

5 X FULL FUEL TANKERS HEADED NORTH ON ROUTE GANNET; 18 X EMPTY TANKERS MOVED SOUTH.

- B. AIR ACTIVITY: THE AIR ACTIVITY IN THE MAGLAJ (BQ 7138) AREA REPORTED IN THE 26 FEB MILINFOSUM WAS NATO RELATED.

THE VISOKO AIRFIELD (BP 6778) IS 2,800 METRES LONG, IS HARD-PAVED, AND HAS A CONCRETE APRON COMPLETED AT THE EAST END. IT IS ASSESSED THAT A C-130 TYPE AIRCRAFT COULD USE THE AIRFIELD AT THIS TIME, APPROACHING FROM THE NE OR SW.

- C. OTHER INFORMATION. REPORTEDLY, THE BOSNIAN SERBS HAVE RENAMED DONJI VAKUF (XL 9190) - SRBOBRAN ("SERBIA RESISTS"), GORNJI VAKUF (YJ 0668) - USKOPLJE, SKENDER BAKUF - KNEZEVO, AND KULEN VAKUF (WK 8533) - SPASOVO.

COMMENT: VAKUF IS AN OTTOMAN LEGACY MEANING "CHARITABLE ENDOWMENT." IT APPEARS THAT THE BOSNIAN SERBS ARE ATTEMPTING TO RID THE AREA OF ALL THINGS MUSLIM.

AN HVO SOURCE OF UNKNOWN RELIABILITY IN GORNJI VAKUF REVEALED THAT THERE IS AT LEAST ONE MERCENARY IN THE AREA, THAT THE HVO OPERATES ON A 15 DAY ON/15 DAY OFF ROTATION PERIOD, THAT THERE IS A SPECIAL GROUP REFERRED TO AS "ALPHA FORCE" WITHIN 1 (HVO) GDS BDE, AND THAT THE LIVNO/KUPRES AREA IS PRESENTLY QUIET.

TRAINING OF RECRUITS CONTINUES IN THE VITEZ EAST AREA (YJ 2292), DESPITE THE RAMADAN PERIOD. COMMENT: THIS MAY POINT TO SOME URGENCY ON THE PART OF THE BIH TO TRAIN ADDITIONAL TROOPS.

LOCALS IN THE GORNJI VAKUF AREA HAVE STATED THAT THE PRESENCE OF THE BSA "TUZLA" LO IS MORE DISTURBING THAN HAVING OTHER BSA LO'S IN HQ SSW BECAUSE THE "TUZLA" LO IS HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SHELLING OF TUZLA.

THE NIGHTLY LEVELS OF PROPAGANDA BEING BROADCAST ON BUGOJNO (XJ 9681) TV HAS DROPPED FROM 90 TO 30 MINUTES.

A D-30 GUN HAS RETURNED TO YK 353480, WITH THE GUN BARREL ORIENTED SW TOWARD TESLIC (YK 2843).

BIH POLICE AT THE CP MIKE BLOCKADE NEAR VISOKO (BP 7575) CLAIM THAT THE BIH SECTION HOLDING THE HIGH GROUND OVERWATCHING THE CP HAVE INSTRUCTIONS TO ENGAGE ANY UN VEHICLE APPROACHING THE CP FROM EITHER DIRECTION.

DURING THE DAY, FEDERATION POLICE HAVE BEEN CONTROLLING ROUTE GANNET IN THE MOSTAR (YJ 2702) AREA.

ON 26 FEB, 4 X HVO SOLDIERS OF 2 (HVO) GDS BDE WERE BURIED IN MOSTAR. THEY HAD REPORTEDLY BEEN KILLED IN ACTION IN THE LIVNO (XJ 6254)-KUPRES (XJ 8375) AREA DURING SMALL BSA ATTACKS AGAINST THE HVO.

THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR WITH NO CFV'S RECORDED. LIMITED BIH MOVEMENT WAS NOTED IN THE SECTOR.

ALONG THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHERN PORTION OF THE CONFRONTATION LINE, SOME DETONATIONS AND SPORADIC SA FIRE WERE REPORTED IN THE DOBOJ FINGER (BQ 7357) AND LUKAVAC (CQ 0335) AREAS.

THE NORTHEAST CONFRONTATION LINE AND SAPNA THUMB REMAINED CALM AND STABLE, EXCEPT FOR THE MAJEVICA HILLS WHERE NUMEROUS SOUNDS RESEMBLING EXPLOSIONS WERE HEARD. THESE SOUNDS MAY HAVE BEEN DISTANT THUNDERSTORM NOISES RATHER THAN WARRING FACTION ACTIVITIES; LOCAL MEDIA DID NOT REPORT ANY INTENSIFIED LEVEL OF ACTIVITY IN THE AREA.

IN THE CENTRAL AREA, THERE WAS AN INCREASE IN LMG/HMG FIRE IN THE VICINITY OF RIBNICA (BQ 9313). BSA SOLDIERS WERE OBSERVED BUILDING SHELTERS AND TRENCHES AT BQ 915142.

IN THE TUZLA AREA, 13 LARGE FUEL TRUCKS LOADING OR UNLOADING THEIR CONTENTS WERE OBSERVED AT A PROBABLE BIH POL STORAGE FACILITY (CQ 135225), JUST SOUTH OF ZIVINICE (CQ 1224). THE TANKERS WERE BELIEVED TO BE UNLOADING.

THE SOUTHERN CONFRONTATION LINE WAS GENERALLY QUIET WITH ONLY SPORADIC SA FIRE.

SREBRENICA (CP 6484) REMAINED FAIRLY QUIET WITH ONLY A FEW FIRING INCIDENTS NOTED.

5. BIHAC. THE SITUATION WITHIN THE POCKET REMAINED STABLE, WITH RELATIVELY LOW LEVELS OF FIRING INCIDENTS AND NO CFV'S TO REPORT.

IN THE VELIKA Kladusa (WL 6303) AREA, THERE WAS A LOW LEVEL OF ACTIVITY WITH ONLY SPORADIC EXPLOSIONS AND SA BURSTS OCCURRING TO THE EAST OF THE BANBAT LOG BASE. SOME TROOP MOVEMENT FROM VELIKA Kladusa TO MALA Kladusa WAS NOTED.

THE WESTERN CONFRONTATION LINE WAS GENERALLY QUIET. LIMITED SA FIRE AND SEVERAL EXPLOSIONS WERE REPORTED.

THE BIHAC TOWN AREA WAS GENERALLY QUIET. THERE WERE SOME EXPLOSIONS AND SPORADIC SA FIRE NOTED IN THE AREAS OF ZEGAR (WK 6760), GRABEZ (WK 7363), SOKOLAC (WK 7160), PRIVILICA (WK 7061), AND PRITOKI GRABEZ (WK 7461). NEAR BOSANSKA KRUPA (WK 9070) AND OTOKA (WK 9179), THE BSA AND BIH WERE INVOLVED IN EXCHANGES OF SA FIRE. THERE WERE ALSO SOME EXPLOSIONS REPORTED IN THE AREA. AFTER A PERIOD OF SEVERAL MONTHS, SEVERAL SHELLS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE LANDED IN CAZIN TOWN CENTRE (WK 7479).

OF INTEREST, A BIH SOURCE CLAIMED THAT THE BSA ATTACKED THE BIH IN THE BOS KRUPA AREA (WK 9170) AT 0600A. THE ATTACK WAS REPORTEDLY SUPPORTED BY A SMALLER ATTACK AT 0900A IN THE AREA OF THE SRBLJANI (WK 7572)/GRMUSA (7972) AREA, AS WELL AS FIRE FROM A HOWITZER BATTERY LOCATED IN THE V RADIC (WK 8365) AREA. (40 ROUNDS OF 122MM HOWITZER WERE REPORTED BY THE BIH TO HAVE LANDED IN THE SRBLJANI AREA BETWEEN 0800-0900A.) THESE ATTACKS WERE REPORTEDLY INTENDED TO RELIEVE PRESSURE ON ABDIC FORCES IN THE NORTH OF THE POCKET. THE ABOVE INFORMATION HAS NOT BEEN INDEPENDENTLY CONFIRMED.

ASSESSMENT. THE POCKET IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN FAIRLY QUIET, ALTHOUGH AN ATTACK AGAINST 5TH CORPS ALONG THE NORTHERN CONFRONTATION LINE, POSSIBLY IN THE MALA Kladusa AREA, MAY BE IMMINENT. ALTHOUGH NUMEROUS ADDITIONAL ARSK TROOPS HAVE REPORTEDLY DEPLOYED NEAR THE NORTHERN BIHAC POCKET BORDER AREA

DURING THE PAST SEVERAL DAYS, THERE ARE NO INDICATIONS THAT THE ARSK WILL FULLY PARTICIPATE IN ANY ATTACK AGAINST 5TH CORPS IN THE NEAR TERM. ANY NEAR-TERM ATTACK IN THE MALA Kladusa AREA IS NOT EXPECTED TO BE MASSIVE, AND NO MAJOR SHIFT IN THE CONFRONTATION LINE EXPECTED TO OCCUR AS A RESULT OF FIGHTING IN THE AREA.
