*Mr. President,*

To my distress I have just been informed that KOSEVO Hospital has today been the target of some shelling by Serb artillery or mortars. At 1500 hours a shell hit part of the Hospital and injured 2 patients, 2 staff, a journalist and a doctor.

I must protest to you in the strongest of terms for this irresponsible attack. There can be no excuse for shelling a hospital. I demand that you take immediate and effective action to ensure that your gunners respect the Geneva Convention.

You should also be aware of the damage that this incident will do to your image abroad and your cause at home. I must emphasise that it is in your own interest to ensure this kind of incident is not repeated.
